



Certified Business Manager (CBM) Credential Use and Misuse Statement 2010 CBM Recertification Cycle

As a part of the ANSI/ISO/IEC 17024 Accreditation Requirements for Personnel Certification Standards, each CBM Certificant must acknowledge the following:

- + I hold the Certified Business Manager (CBM) Credential from The Association of Professionals in Business Management (APBM), NFP based on its CBM certification scheme
- + I intend to use the CBM Credential on my resume, business card, employment application, school admissions application, or for any other good cause
- + I do not claim that the CBM Credential is equal to an MBA degree or higher
- + I will put Retired CBM next to my name on business cards or other places when I am retired to indicate my status with the APBM
- + I will not use the CBM Credential if I do not adhere to the annual recertification requirements, thereby becoming inactive with APBM
- + I do not and will not use the CBM Credential in any misleading manner either in my job or outside of my job
- + If found using the CBM Credential in any misleading manner, I will be subject to disciplinary actions sanctioned by APBM's Board of Governors
